The goal of Idaho's mobility network is to help people move from place to place by using a mix of transportation modes.



COMMUNITY NETWORKS
Every community has unique mobility needs and values, so Idaho's model focuses on a grass-roots effort led by local leaders, users, providers, service agencies and other stakeholders. These local stakeholders tailor options, strategies and priorities respective to their community's mobility needs.

DISTRICTS NETWORKS
District networks support and coordinate the mobility efforts of two or more community networks. They also develop strategies and plans for the region at large to support mobility.

STATE NETWORKS
Community and district strategies are woven together to create a growing statewide system that connects people in Idaho through a mix of transportation options.
